Chapter 4 of "The Ice Cream Villain" is available on your 2dos. I have had a couple of great pieces of feedback (that people are enjoying the story) and some brilliant work based on the story! As with last week, a new chapter means a new comprehension quiz.

I would like you to write the next section of the story. If you are in school this week, we will do this in class, so you don't need to worry about doing this on Purple Mash! The next section of the story is "the chase". The children are chasing the van and they need to catch it. How will they manage it? These are always the most exciting parts of books and films, so we need our writing to be the same. With the children in school, we will come up with a list of adverbs, adjectives and we will practice using speech marks in our writing.

On Tuesday, a definitions task will appear in your 2dos. In this task, you need to find the definition/ meaning of some of the trickier words from the story. You can use a kids dictionary (if you have one at home) or an online kids dictionary like:

Don't just copy and paste an answer. Read, understand, and put in your own words.

On Wednesday the spelling quizzes for the week will appear in your 2dos. I will also add a spelling, punctuation and grammar task to your 2dos which asks you to write a sentence with correct punctuation, use connectives.

On Friday, the real version of the chase chapter (Chapter 5) will appear in your 2dos. The year 2s and 3s in class with me will read this chapter in class and we will answer the comprehension questions.
