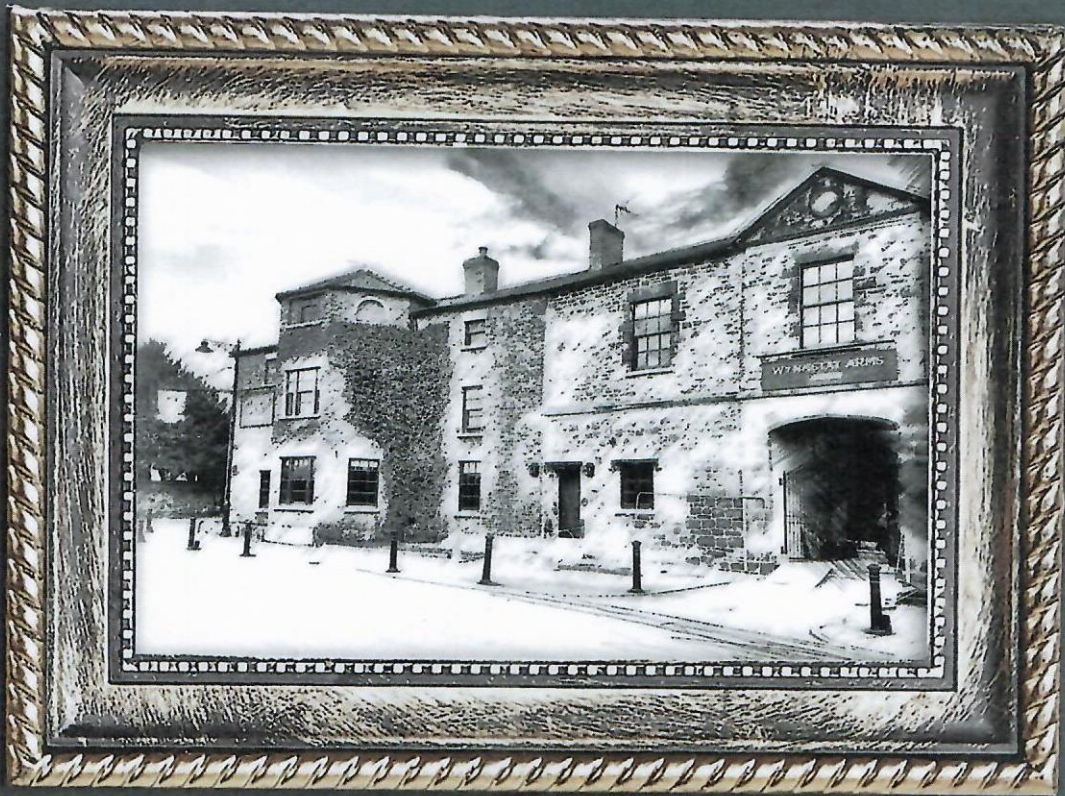

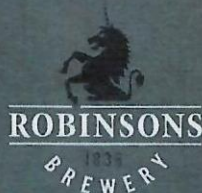

Ruabon - 19th Century Coach House

This former coaching inn dates mainly from the late 18th century, with additions made in 1841. It probably incorporates parts of an earlier structure. Behind the inn, the 18th-century stable block still stands. This side of Ruabon belonged to the large Wynnstay Estate. You can see a gateway into the estate at the far end of the informal square along Park Street.

In the last decades of the 19th century the inn was run by the Murless family. By the early 20th century the lease was held by brothers Philip and Cresswell Murless. Both went to South Africa with the Imperial Yeomanry at the time of the Boer War.
