Dinner Money

It is important your child's dinner account does not go into debt. Our cook is not allowed to provide a meal to anyone whose debt goes over £12 but as a school we do not wish this to happen. It's so easy to pay for meals either by popping a cheque into the box in reception, by cash in the machine in reception or by paying online through Wrexham County Borough Council's payment system. If you are unsure how to use any of these systems, please ask Mrs Antrobus. We also have forms for you to complete to apply for Free School Meals. Please don't assume you will automatically receive FSM if you are on a benefit, YOU STILL HAVE TO APPLY. Mrs Antrobus will help you with completing the forms if you need any assistance.
