**School Meals** School dinner balances have started to accrue debts. We are not allowed to serve a meal out if it hasn't been paid for. Eisteddfod Day The whole school will enjoy a free day out on Tuesday thanks to the Arts Council of Wales grant. Children will need to bring a packed lunch, plenty to drink (plastic bottles/cups with lids) and must wear their uniforms with comfortable footwear. Hats & sunscreen will be needed if it's sunny, or raincoats if we're unlucky to have a grey day. Please remember there will be no nursery on this day.

**Flu Vaccinations** Reception to Year 5 will all have taken home consents & information leaflets on the nasal spray flu vaccines. Although these aren't scheduled until 6<sup>th</sup> November, the school nurse is requesting that we receive all envelopes back by 5<sup>th</sup> July so they can co-ordinate the visit. Please return the envelopes stating whether you agree to vaccination or do not agree to vaccination.

**Lateness & attendance** In one week alone, one of our classes missed a total of 102 minutes due to children arriving late. Not only is the class disturbed by late arrivals, the register is missed and the dinner register is missed causing extra work for staff. Also:

- Please make sure you arrange medical and dental appointments for after school where-ever possible.
- Keeping your child at home for 48 hours after sickness and diarrhoea ensures it is not passed on to the rest of school.
- For safeguarding reasons please do not drop children off outside school after breakfast club closes, they cannot be left unattended.

**School Carpark** It is council policy in all schools that no pedestrian access is allowed in staff carparks, more so at our school where the area is raised and surrounded by walls making it impossible when reversing to see anyone walking through the carpark.
