Literacy –

There is a spelling quiz on Purple Mash for everyone. This would be the set of words the children would be doing in their spelling books, were they in school. They would normally practice them each morning and have a test on them at the end of the week. They could have a couple of goes at the quiz to practice making the words. If they normally do a spelling test with me (not Mrs. Davies) there will be an extra 2do on Friday where they need to type the word instead of dragging the letters into place.

Some fun tongue twisters to have a go at reading: Challenge someone in your house to read them quickly.

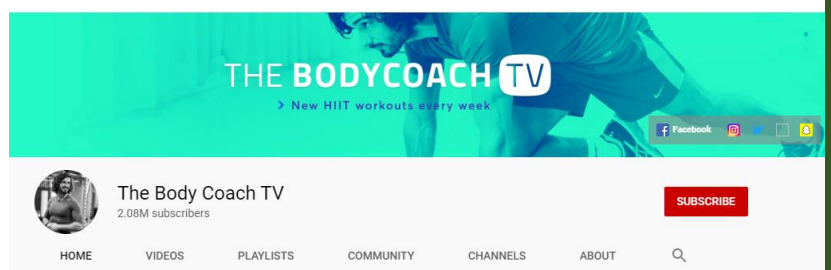
A big black bug bit a big black bear,

Maths –

Use the Make Your Own Times Table Song app to make a song helping you remember some tricky times tables.	Look around your house and make a list of things with more than 5 sides.	Have a go at the “Name 2D shapes” card-matching task in your 2dos. It only has the names of shapes we looked at in class together in.	Have a go at playing “Hit the Button” for a Times Table you do not know very well. https://www.topmarks.co.uk/maths-games/hit-the-button	Open the Regular or Irregular quiz in your 2dos and have a go at solving it.
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Science/Topic – Investigate light using a torch. What happens to the shadow when – a) when the torch is very close, b) when the torch is very far away, c) when you use a bright torch, d) when you use a dimmer torch, e) when you use a bigger item, f) when you use a smaller item. Show what you find out in a creative way.



Art/Design and technology – There are lots of famous painting of Jesus eating with his friends. This is probably the most famous. It is the meal called the Last Supper. It is the last meal Jesus had with his friends before the he died for us. Create some art of you eating with your friends or family during a special meal. You could do
