

Phonics and Spellings

This week, the sounds you will need to look at are as follows;

'oa'- goat in a boat' (float, coat, toast, toad, loaf)

'ew'- chew the stew (blew, flew, crew, brew, drew)

'ire'- fire, fire! (wire, admire, hire, bonfire, tire)

Practice these sounds verbally every day. I would also like you to write the words down independently and if you can, put the words into a sentence.

Literacy

Monday- Today, I would like you to write all about your Christmas holidays. This year, Christmas was a little bit different for everyone but I'm sure you all had a wonderful time and have lots that you could write about. I have attached some tips that you need to remember when writing a recount and a template for you to use if you would like.

Tuesday- Recently, we have seen lots of cold weather including frosty mornings and even snow. Today, I would like you to write a poem about the month of January (Ionawr)

I would like you to make a list of things that you see outside during the month of January...if you can you could even go into your garden or for a walk and have a look around to help you do this. Then, I would like you to write an acrostic poem all about the month of 'January'. Remember, start your sentence with each letter of the word. I have attached some examples of an acrostic poem to help you and a template for you to use if you would like. It does not have to rhyme!

Maths

Monday- Our first maths topic for this half term will be measure. Firstly, I would like you to go on a scavenger hunt around your house and find 10 items. I would like you to order the items from shortest to tallest. Then measure your items and record your answers.

If you are in Year 2, you can use lego blocks or something similar to measure your items. If you are in Year 3 and 4 and have access to a ruler or tape measure, please use cm to measure your items. Record this either on the template attached or in your own way.

Tuesday- Following on from yesterday, I have set some tasks for Year 2 on Purple mash and attached a work sheet to be completed by Year 3 and 4. If any Year 2's would like to do this as well, please do.
