

Phonics and Spellings

This week, the sounds you will need to look at are as follows;

'ear' hear with you ear (dear, fear, hear, year, beard, gear)
'ure' sure it's pure (cure, lure, secure, mature, picture, mixture)

Practice these sounds verbally every day. I would also like you to write the words down independently and if you can, put the words into a sentence.

Literacy

Monday- Last week, you wrote an acrostic poem and started to look at rhyming words and syllables.

Today, I would like you to plan a winter poem that will rhyme. Firstly, I would like you to make a spider diagram with as many words as you can think of linking to winter.

List items/objects and things you can see but also think about adjectives to describe what winter is like. For example, frozen, cold, shivering, white, glistening. Then list any of the words that rhyme. You may have to add some. For example, **shivering and glistening- they both end with 'ing'**.


Now have a go at writing some sentences that rhyme, that you could use in your poem. This would be mine-

**All wrapped up, people are shivering,
Loud wind, hard ice, snow glistening.**

Remember, this is your plan, so keep trying and see what you can come up with.

Maths

Monday- Last week, you were looking at measure. You had a go at measuring items using your tape measure or ruler. Today we will be looking at measuring the perimeter of a shape. This means measuring the length all around the outside.



Have a look at the rectangle above. The two sides that are parallel measure the same. To work out the perimeter, I will add $10 + 10 + 5 + 5 = 30\text{cm}$.

There are two sheets attached. One has smaller numbers and one has larger numbers. Use the one you feel most confident with.

(The shapes are not drawn to size).

Topic

Last week, you looked back in time to the year you were born and then looked at 1990's and 1980's. This week we will be learning about the 1970's and 1960's.


You may have heard of the famous film 'Star Wars'. Some of you may have watched some of them, or maybe your parents have. The first ever Star Wars film was made in the 1970's!


Star Wars Creature Creator
