This week, the sounds you will need to look at are as follows:

'ow' **Brown Cow** (down, gown, howl, owl, frown, crown)

'tion' **Pay attention it's a celebration** (conversation, celebration, exploration, tradition, attention, congratulations)

Monday-

Key

Blue- capital letters

Pink- full stops

Green- commas

Monday- Today, we are going to be looking at capacity.

Challenge- I would like you to have a look for some different containers around your house, you may find these in your kitchen. Have a look at which container would hold the most, and which container would hold the least. See if you can put them in size order. If you can, put your photo on Seesaw.


Chilblains and Semolina Pudding


Measuring Volume

Aim: I can measure volume of liquid in millilitres.


Approximately how much water is in each jug?






