Year 1 Activities

Draw 20 houses on a street. 10 on one side of the road and 10 on the other. Write all the odd numbers on one side of the street. Can you do it without filling in the evens?

Make a chart with 10 boxes across and 10 boxes down. Write the numbers 1 to 10 across the top. Now 11 to 20 on the next line. Keep going until you reach 100. If the last box isn't 100 then you have made a mistake. This is called a 100 square.

On your 100 square, colour in the even numbers from 1 to 20. Now colour in the odd numbers 21 to 99. It should be easy if you can find the pattern!

Ask a member of your family to shout out numbers for you to write. Make sure the numbers are the correct way around. This is really important!!!!

2Do: 2Handwrite Let's practice some letters. The letters r n m b h all start with r

Practise writing ee words. Make a list of as many as you can find. There is an activity sheet for you to complete on Seesaw

Look, Say, Cover, Write. Learn to spell the ee words. Look at the word, say it, cover it up and try to write it. If you are correct then go to the next. Try again later. Did you remember how to spell the ee words? Ask someone to test you ☺
