

## All about me! Week beginning 22<sup>nd</sup> February

We are starting this term with a two-week topic of all about me. These activities are suitable for everyone so please do as many as you can!

Read/ Listen to the story the colour monster by Anna Llenas.

As you are going through the story, think about what makes you feel happy, sad, angry, fear and calm. I have attached a power point of the book for you to read or listen using the sound buttons to the book.

If you where the colour monster, what colour would you be? Colour the monster template to match your feelings.

Look at the pictures of the colour monsters, how do you think they are feeling? Colour the monsters in the colour you think they are and add a sentence to explain why.

Draw around your hand and can you write five facts about you on each finger?

See the phonics snakes and ladders game to practice your sounds!

In Maths we are going to be looking at adding and subtracting zero. This video from bbc iplayer covers the concept of zero:

Attached are some equations to add and subtract zero. Use the images to help you.

Remember: when subtracting zero, you must always have the larger number at the start of the equation and subtract zero from this number.

Can you make your own equations?

Using a piece of string, can you measure your height? Once you have done this, lay the string on the floor, how many footsteps/ handprints tall are you?

Can you complete the dot to dot picture? Start at one and count on joining up the dots as you go, what picture do you get?

During this topic we are going to be looking at what makes us unique. Can you make a self-portrait (no bigger than A4) of your face? This can be using pens, pencils, paints or even collage! I have attached some templates to help with this or you can draw your own. Use a mirror to help with this!

Make the colour monster dice and roll the dice, can you move around like a happy, sad, angry, fear or calm monster?

Can you dance like a monster? In this video, Oti teaches us some monster moves!
