

WREXHAM COUNCIL ANNOUNCEMENT

"It has now been confirmed that Foundation Phase pupils in Wrexham will start returning to schools from Friday 26th February. This decision reflects the continuing fall in positive cases of Covid 19 in Wrexham."

This means that on Friday, 26th February, pupils in years Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 can come back to school.

Please can Y2 meet at the gate at 8.50am; YR – Y1 meet at the gate at 9.00am; Nursery meet at the gate at 12.45pm.

Please collect the children from the gate at 3pm.

Teacher Miss Sobczak will be teaching the class until the end of term, she's really excited to be teaching you and looking forward to meeting the class. She's had a zoom meeting with Miss Jesson and has planned some lovely activities.

(Key worker children please meet at the driveway gate at 8.50am and maintain social distancing from the other class bubbles. Please collect your children at 3.15pm).

Please can children bring a simple packed lunch that they can eat themselves. If your child needs fruit cutting, please send it in already cut up, in a bag or tub that they can open. We have paper water cones in school and cooled, fresh water is always available. Please don't bring drinks bottles, toys, pencil cases etc into school.

At last, this is great news and we are all really looking forward to greeting the Foundation Phase pupils back into school. Hopefully, the rest of the school will be back soon too.

KEY WORKER CHILD CARE

We are providing childcare for Key Worker's children. If you need Key Worker childcare, please email Mrs Whitgreave ASAP on:

Please be aware that there are specific criteria for Key Worker provision that the school is duty-bound to follow.

Please drop children off at the main footpath gate at 8.50am and collect at 3.15pm.

Please bring sandwiches and leave bags, drinks bottles, toys, pencil cases etc, at home.

The children will be doing the work from their class online provision on the days they are in school.

If your child displays any of the Covid19 symptoms, please keep them at home and **contact 119** for further advice.

If you have been in direct contact with someone with Covid19, please isolate for the time directed by track and trace and **contact 119** if you need further advice.

If your child becomes unwell or starts to display symptoms in school, they will go to a safe isolation area and you will need to be able to come and collect your child immediately.

Please wear a mask and keep social distancing when you drop off and collect your child.

I will keep you updated with the information as soon as I can, after I receive it.

Do stay safe and well everyone. We all look forward to welcoming you all back into school as soon as we can and hope that we can return as soon as possible.
