

Dear Parents,

WELSH GOVERNMENT ANNOUNCEMENT

Welsh Government have announced that learners in the Foundation Phase will come back to school on 22nd February, in a phased way, with all Foundation Phase children being back in school by the Friday. This applies to children in the year groups: Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and Year 2, so it will involve two of our classes and sets of teachers. The other children will still have their blended learning sessions plus provision will continue to be made for the children of keyworkers.

At Eyton, this will take a little time to plan as we are a three class school and two classes will be involved with Foundation Phase provision, whilst keyworker and blended learning provision will also continue. Therefore, I will write again to you next week, when I have had the opportunity to work out a provision map and share it with staff and governors.

KEY WORKER CHILD CARE

We are providing childcare for Key Worker's children. If you need Key Worker childcare, please email Mrs Whitgreave ASAP on:

Please be aware that there are specific criteria for Key Worker provision that the school is duty-bound to follow.

Please drop children off at the main footpath gate at 8.50am and collect at 3.15pm.

Please bring sandwiches and leave bags, drinks bottles, toys, pencil cases etc, at home.

The children will be doing the work from their class online provision on the days they are in school.

If your child displays any of the Covid19 symptoms, please keep them at home and **contact 119** for further advice.

If you have been in direct contact with someone with Covid19, please isolate for the time directed by track and trace and **contact 119** if you need further advice.

If your child becomes unwell or starts to display symptoms in school, they will go to a safe isolation area and you will need to be able to come and collect your child immediately.

Please wear a mask and keep social distancing when you drop off and collect your child.

I will keep you updated with the information as soon as I can, after I receive it.

Do stay safe and well everyone, there is even more snow forecast this weekend and for next week! We all look forward to welcoming you all back into school as soon as we can and hope that we can return as soon as possible.
