


## A Gentle Reminder





We just need to practise asking for things. You will be surprised how many Welsh words we remember!




# Alert to Lego lovers!!!!

## Landmarks in Lego

Did you know the world's most famous bricks were once manufactured in Wrexham? Initially produced in a factory on Hugmore Lane, later the company built a distribution centre on Ruthin Road. Until **7th May**, Wrexham Museum is hosting 'Brick Built', an exhibition by Warren Elsmore of famous landmarks in miniature, plus models and products from the earliest years of Lego to the present.
