



### *Week 4 By Seren H & Lily*

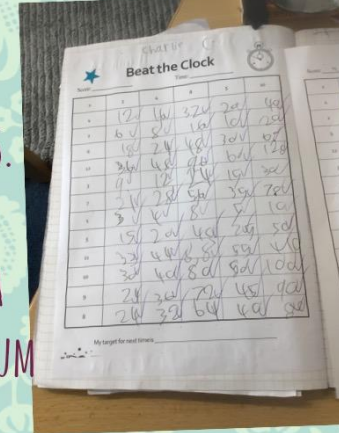
