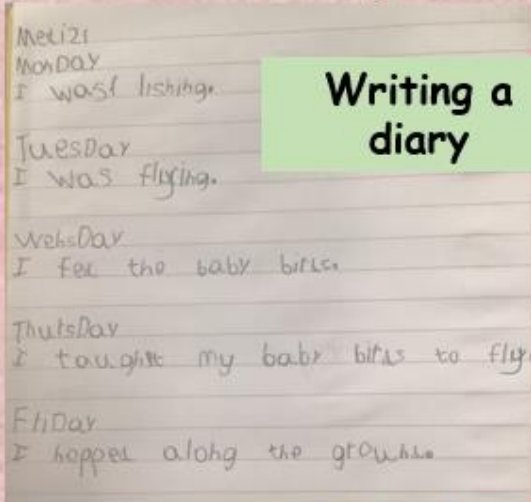

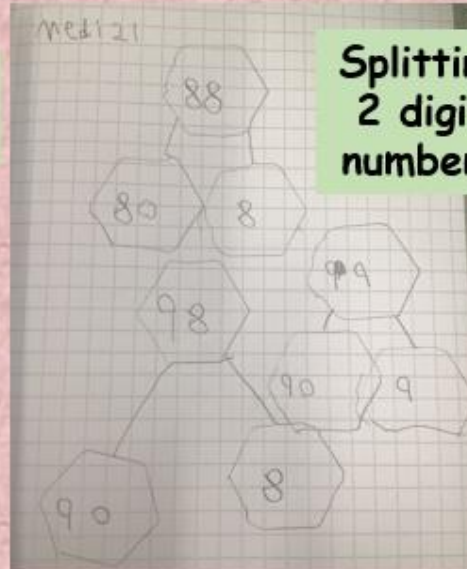
Dosbarth Caradog.

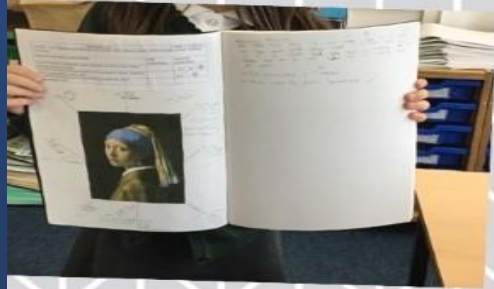

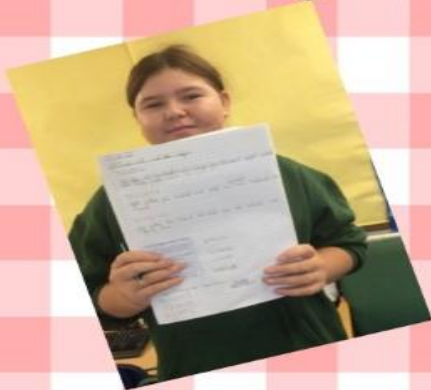

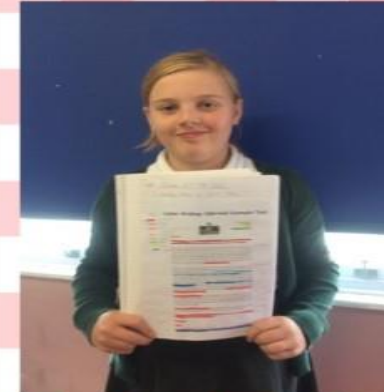
We partitioned and ordered decimal numbers as well as writing them in words.
