### Shoe box appeal

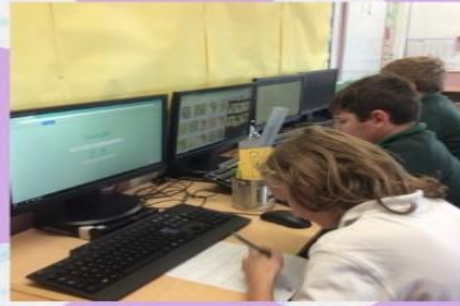
Shoe boxes will be collected on the 11th of November. Please bring them in the first few days of the new term. If you want to bring them in before school breaks up we can keep them safe.

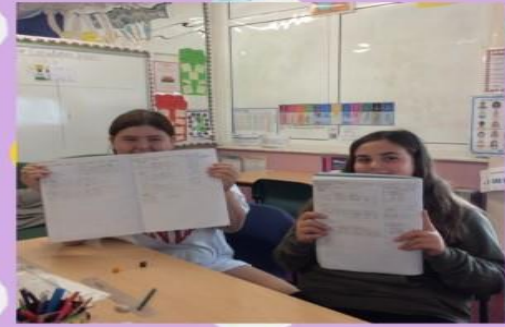

We identified different word classes in grammar.



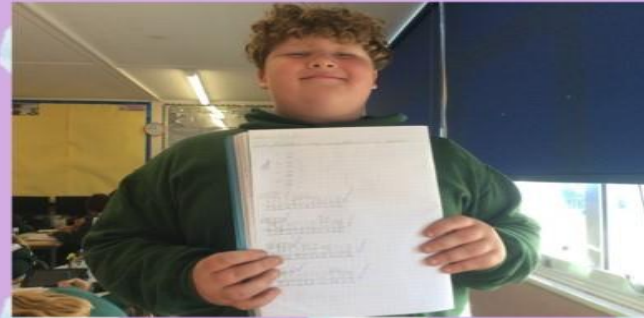
We did research about Nelson Mandela.

We learnt all about Black History Month which is October in the UK.

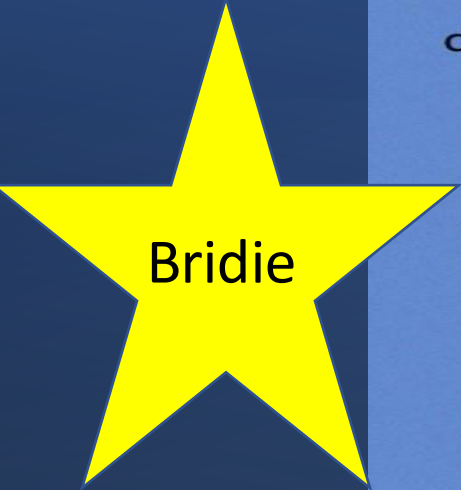


We imagined we were Nelson Mandela and we wrote a diary entry from his point of view.

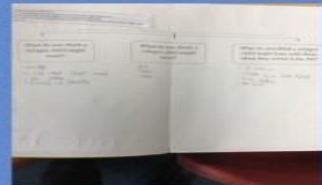
We researched fruit for the harvest festival.
