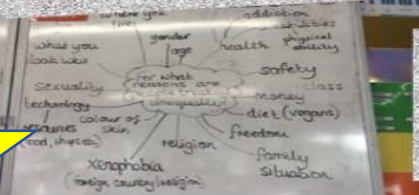
Mrs Rowlands from the Wrexham Refugee Support charity talked to us about how she helps refugees.



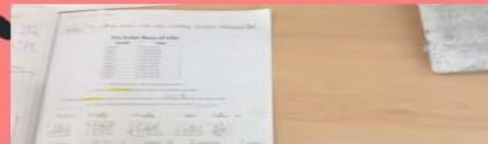
Miss Ellis from Borrass Park School and 3 children came in to talk about being deaf and to answer our questions.

On Monday, we had a visit from Refugee kindness and Borja's Primary hearing impaired unit.

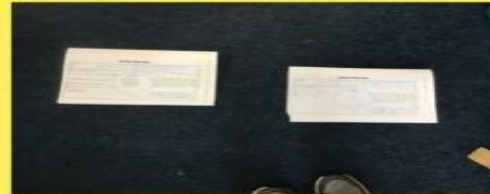
We have create newsround specials about refugees.
