Christmas plays

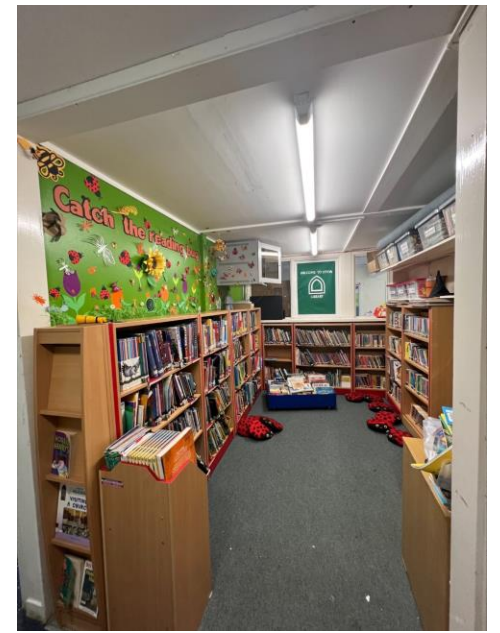
The school plays will be on Tuesday the 13th of December. An afternoon and evening performance. Times to be confirmed.

Shoe boxes will be collected on the 18h of November. Please bring them in to school.

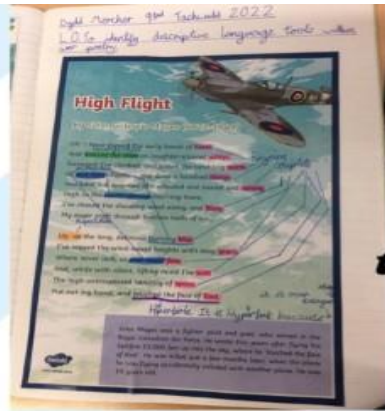


We have been adding a few changes to the school. The children have enjoyed adding their handprints to the wall and making some lovely crafts to add.





We have been learning about Remembrance Day and Armistice day. We studied 'In Flanders Fields' and learnt more about the poppy symbol.

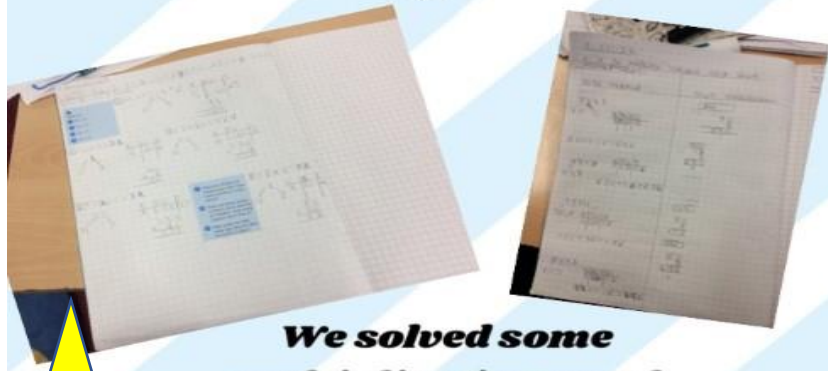


We looked for descriptive language tools in war poetry.



We performed war poems in our groups.

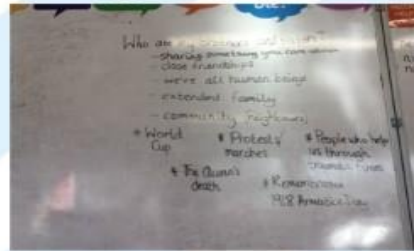
