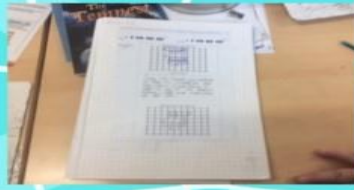

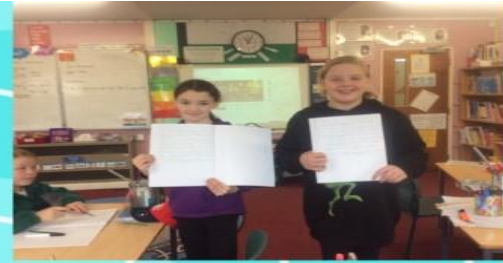

one of our party packages.



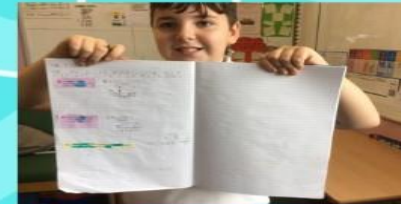
FOR MATHS WE DID FIND AND FIX. THERE WERE LOTS OF MISTAKES AND WE HAD TO CORRECT THEM.

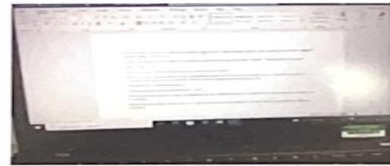
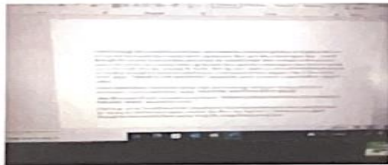

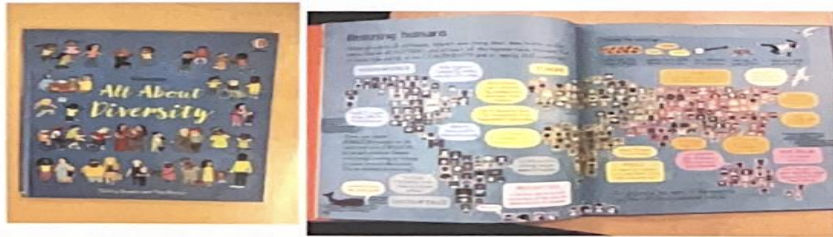
