Thank you to Chrissie's dad for fixing the notice board. We really appreciate it.

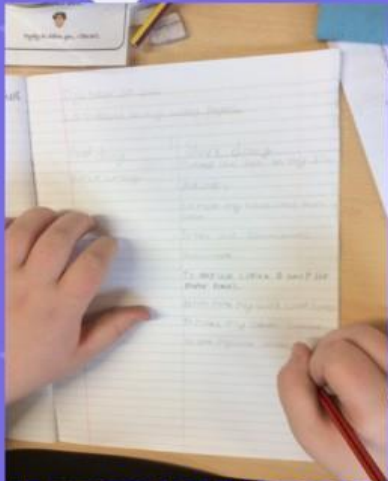
Hire of the school hall

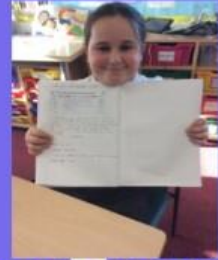
