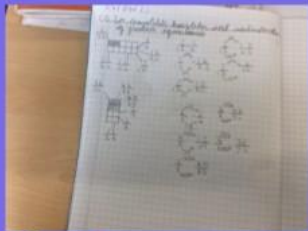


Week 2 Dosbarth Glyndwr By Betsan and Lily!



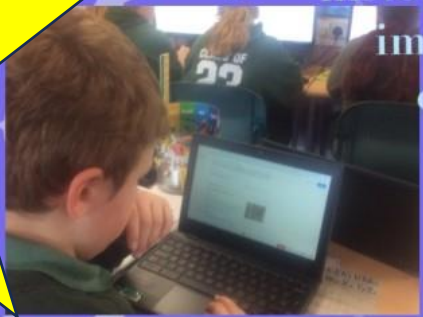
We read more of our class book 'Revenge of the Red Club'.

Paul came in to show us some life saving skills.

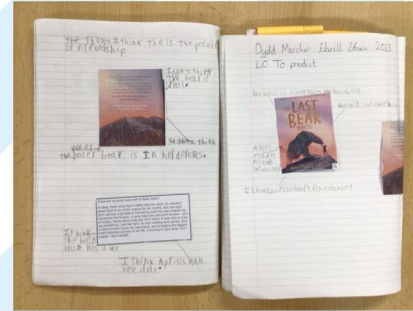


We thought about all the different fractions topics and reflected on how much we've learnt about compared to before Christmas. We'd all made lots of progress.



In gymnastics we started looking at movements.

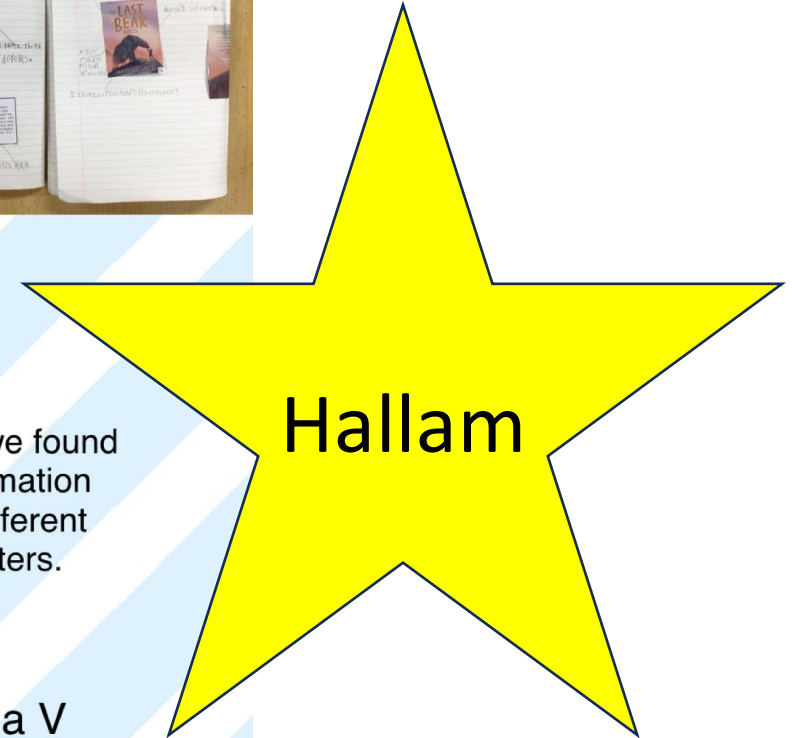
We have started reading The Last Bear. For this book we are going to use the Kindles.

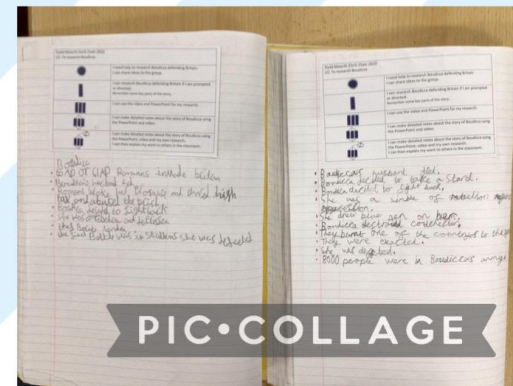
