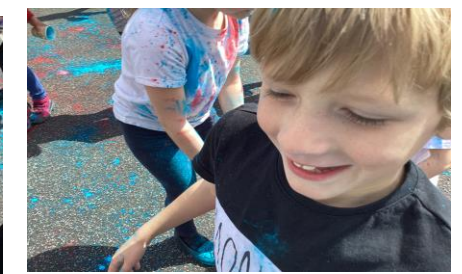
### Can you help?

Please encourage the children to complete the read around the planets sponsored read. It is the reading journey that is so important. Please bring sheets in on a Friday.

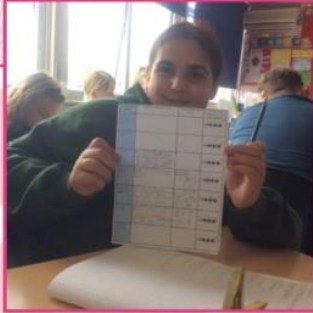








We recapped how to do different things with fractions. If you don't use, you lose it!
