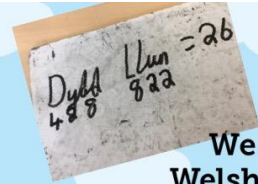

Forest School upgrade

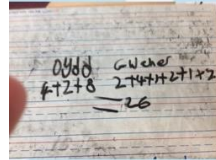
Idea	Resources needed

Week 5 by Lily and Jake



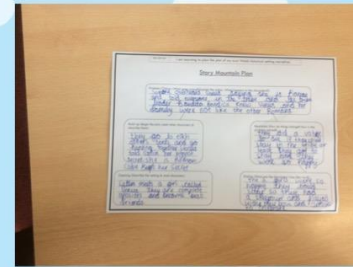
We played Welsh scrabble.

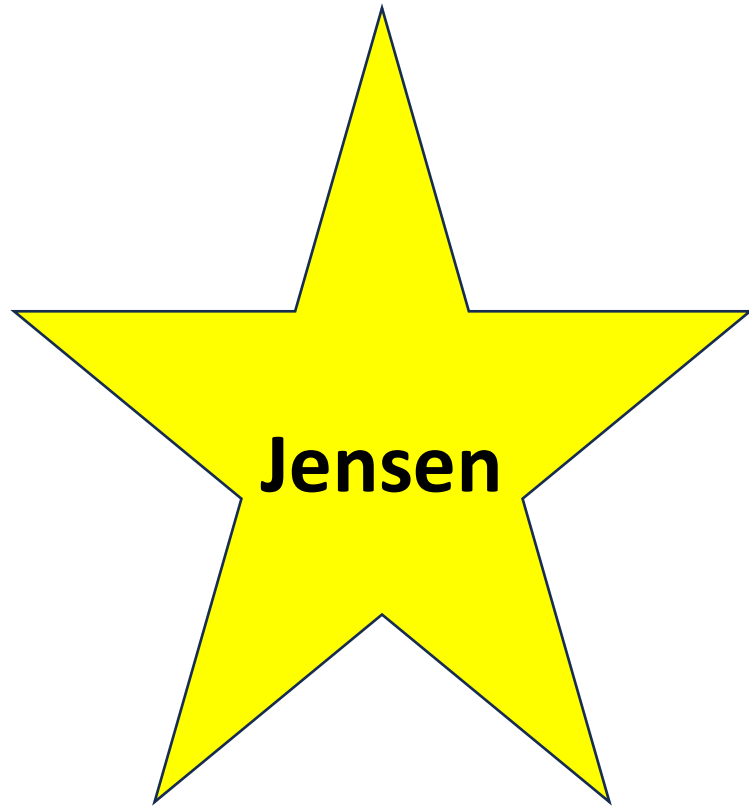


