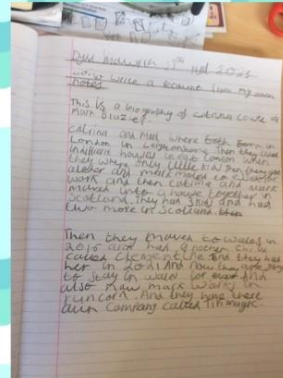
Dosbarth Glyndwr Week 6 By Harry and Hannah

We used our notes to make a recount about the parents' lives.



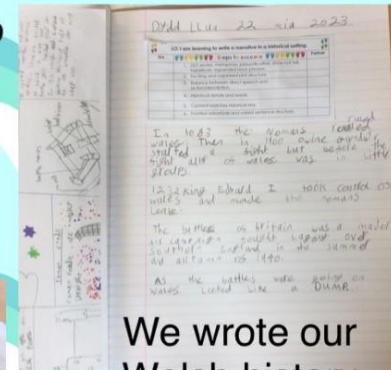
We did length, mass and capacity outside.
