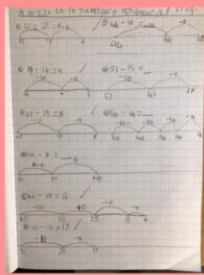
Clothing

Healthy Snacks

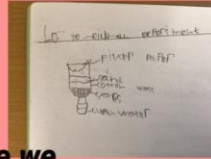

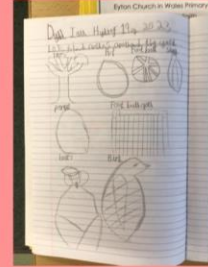
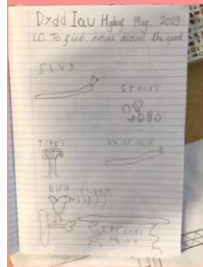
We went on a noun hunt on the yard.



We have started looking at subtraction.



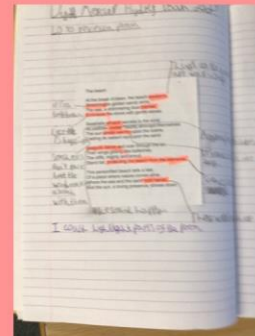
In science we thought of new ways to separate mixtures.

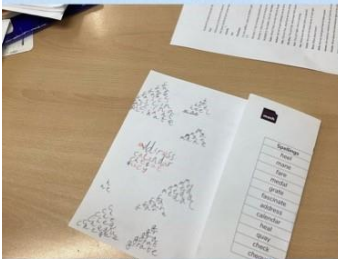
This week was black history week and we talked a lot about racism, equal rights and diversity.



On Monday we did our harvest festival rehearsal.

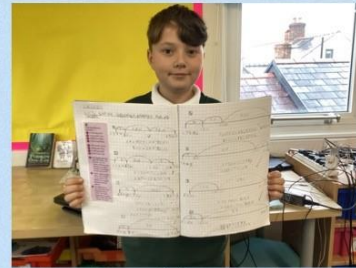


We watched part of Martin Luther King's I have a dream speech. Then we added missing punctuation to it.

We researched famous black people and made fact files. Then we did some drama about important times their lives.



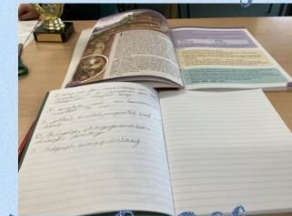
We did finding the difference in maths. We used this to find how long famous black people lived for.

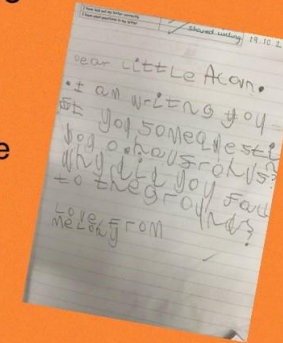

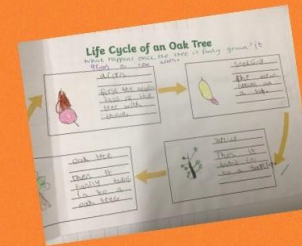

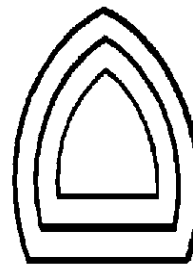
