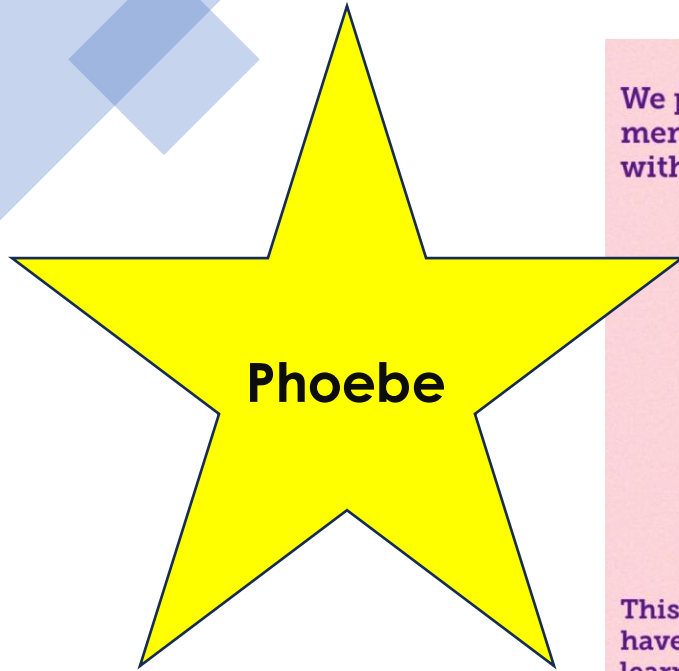

analogue clocks.

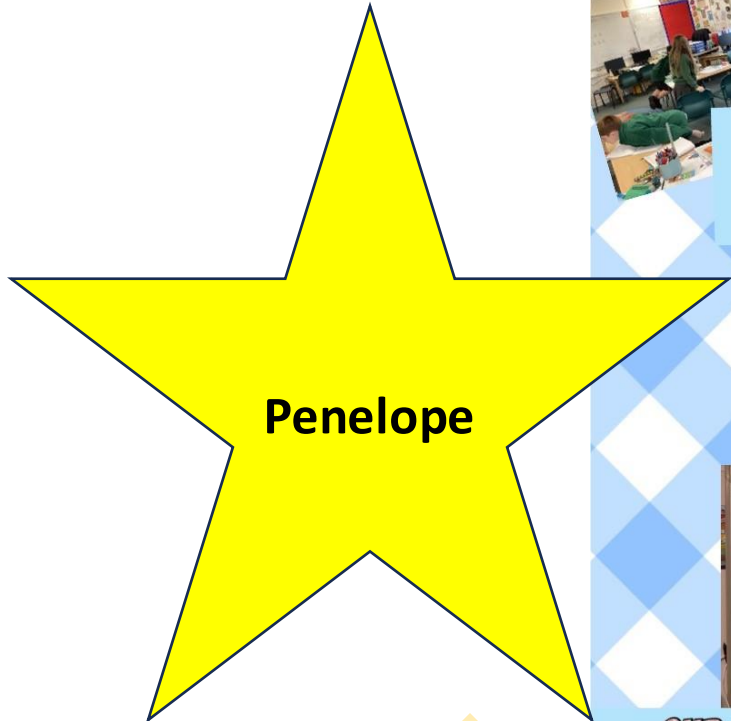

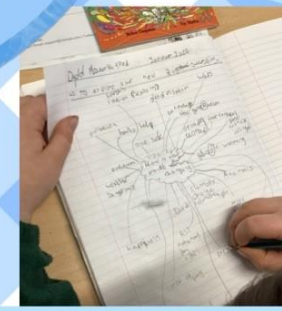

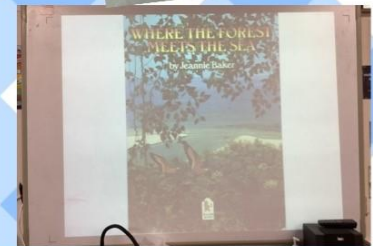
