We are looking for Easter egg donations for our Easter bingo. If you would like to donate anything, please send them into school.

















<u>Swimming</u>

Following a governing body meeting on 6th March 2024:

Dosbarth Drudwen parents: Currently we are overspent on our swimming bus budget by over £400. With the budget cuts this year, school cannot sustain this type of loss. Please could you pay for the swimming bus via parent pay or you can pay in cash in the office.

Dosbarth Pâl: For the children to go swimming, please could you pay the bus fair in advance, so that we can book and pay for the bus. The children will have 10 weeks of swimming at £4 per journey which makes £40.

Unfortunately, if we don't receive these monies, we will have to stop swimming lessons for the younger pupils, which we don't want to do.
