Do you have any topsoil that we could use for the school garden please.

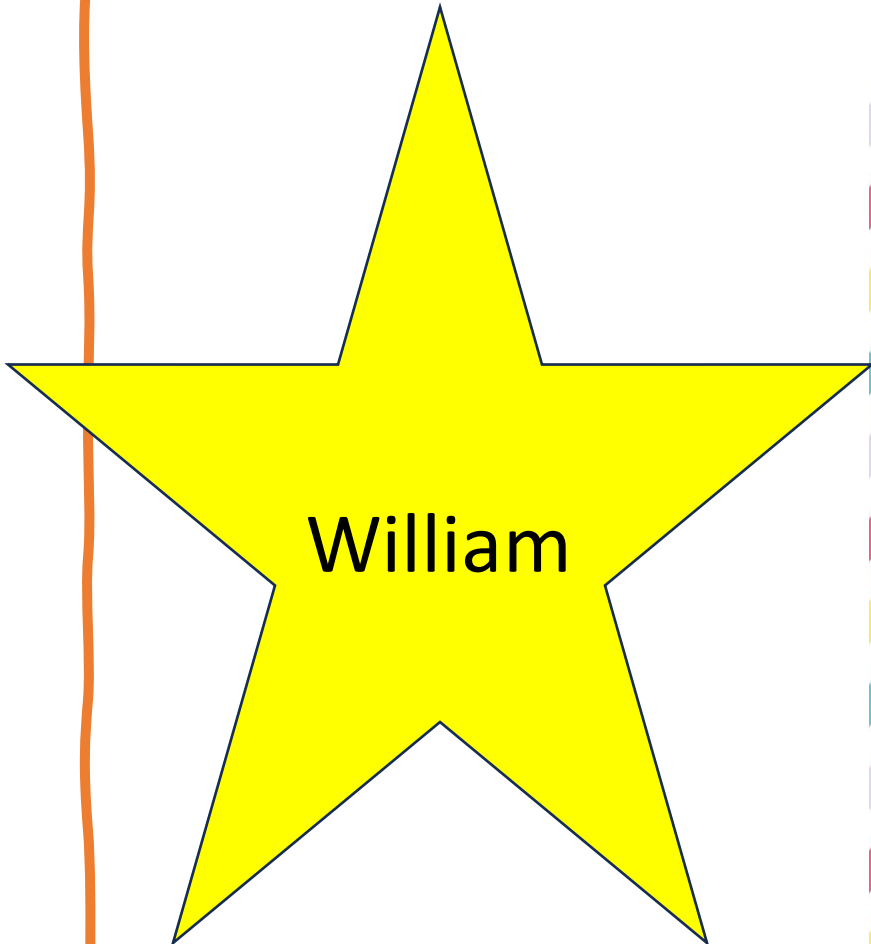

We used Scratch Jr to program different directions.



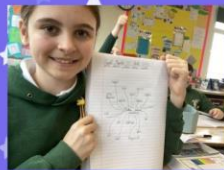
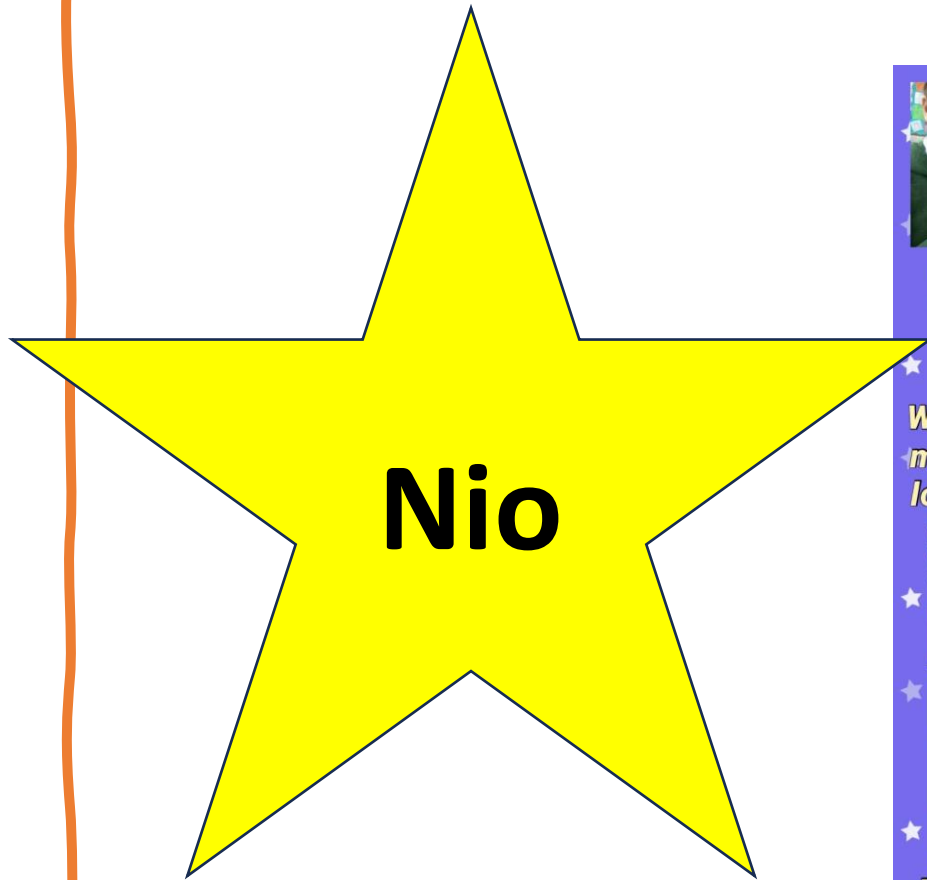
We made a colour wheel and learned about primary and secondary colours.
