Term time holidays

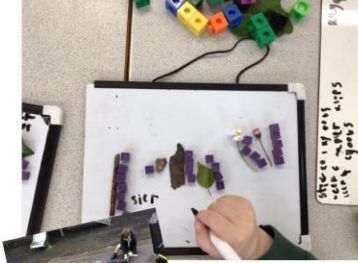
