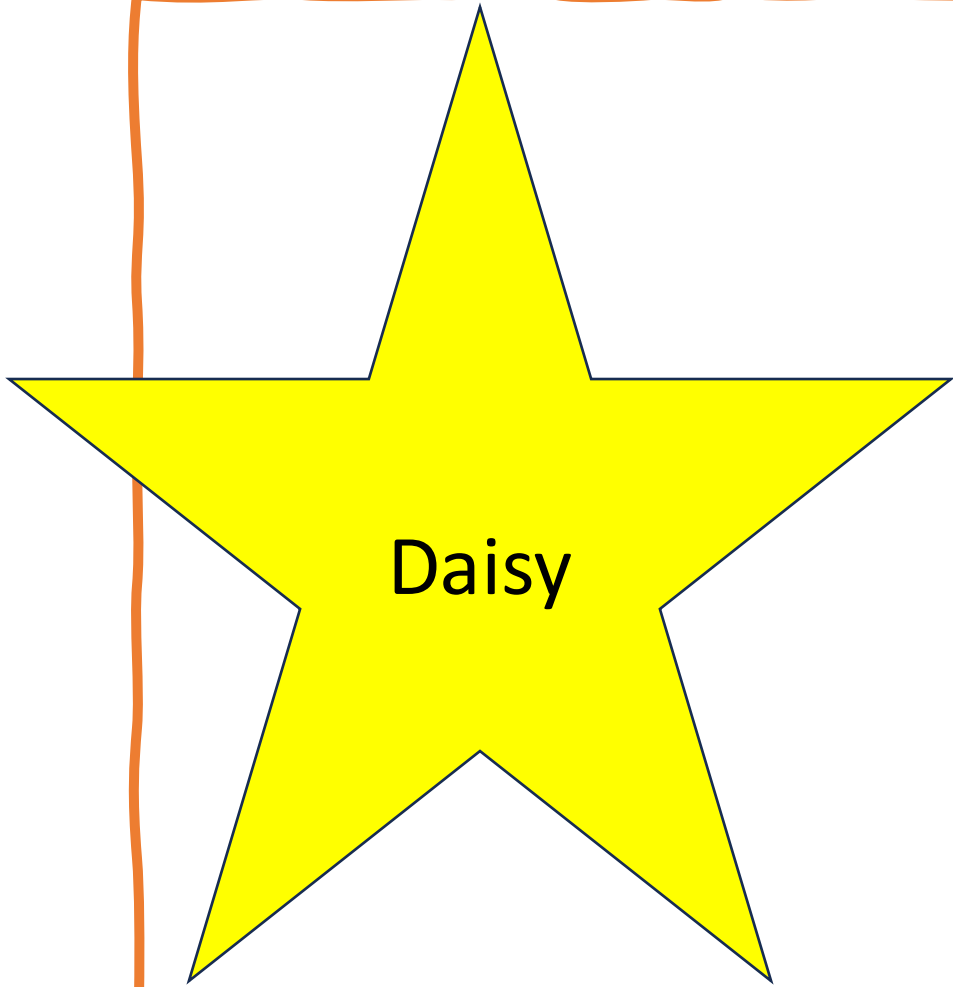
If anyone would like to make a mood board of what parents and children would like to see in our outdoor area, please do so.
