Relief breakfast cook

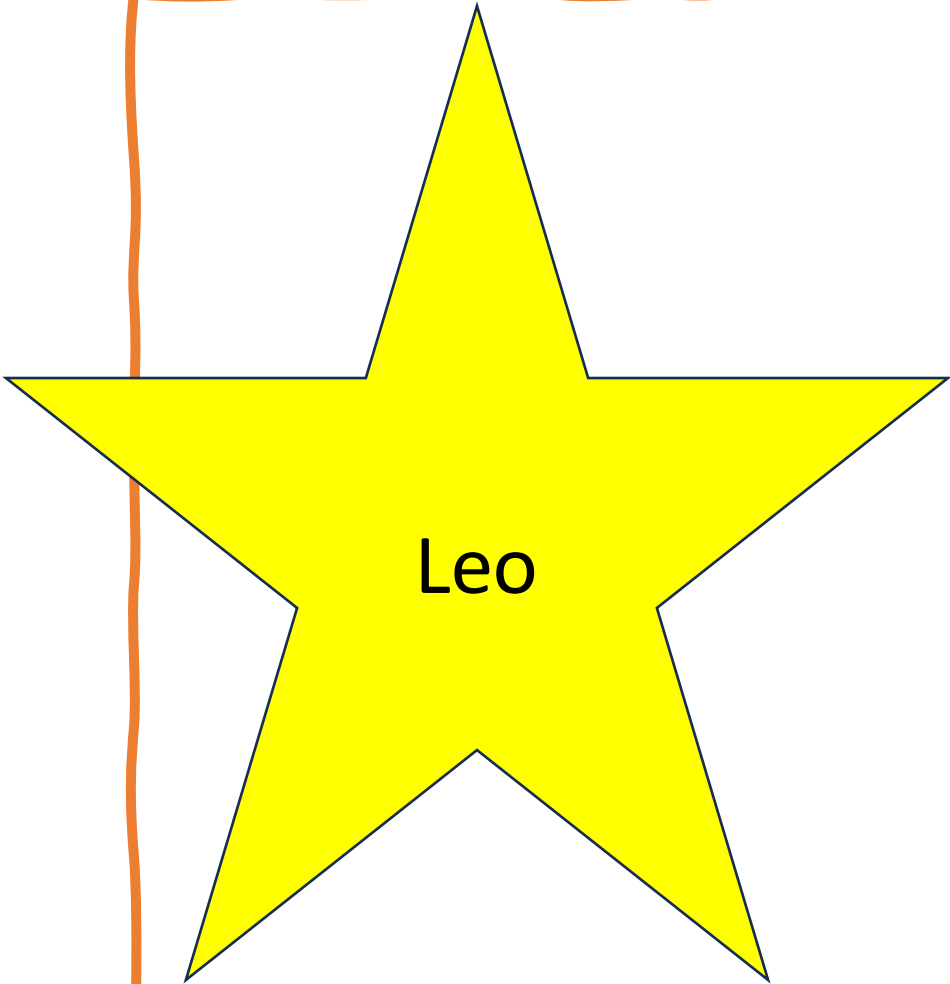

Sports day

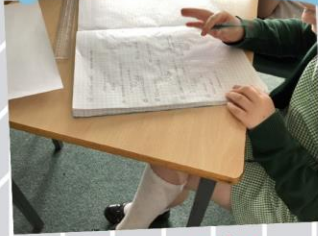
Sports day will be on Tuesday the 2nd of July. With Wednesday the 3rd as a backup day if the weather is not suitable on the 2nd. Running times to follow.

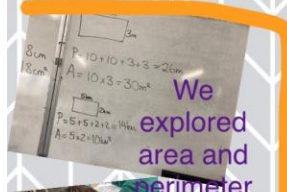

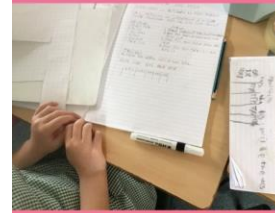

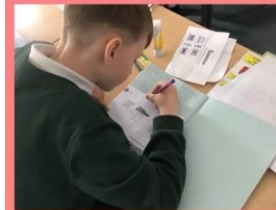
