Breakfast club

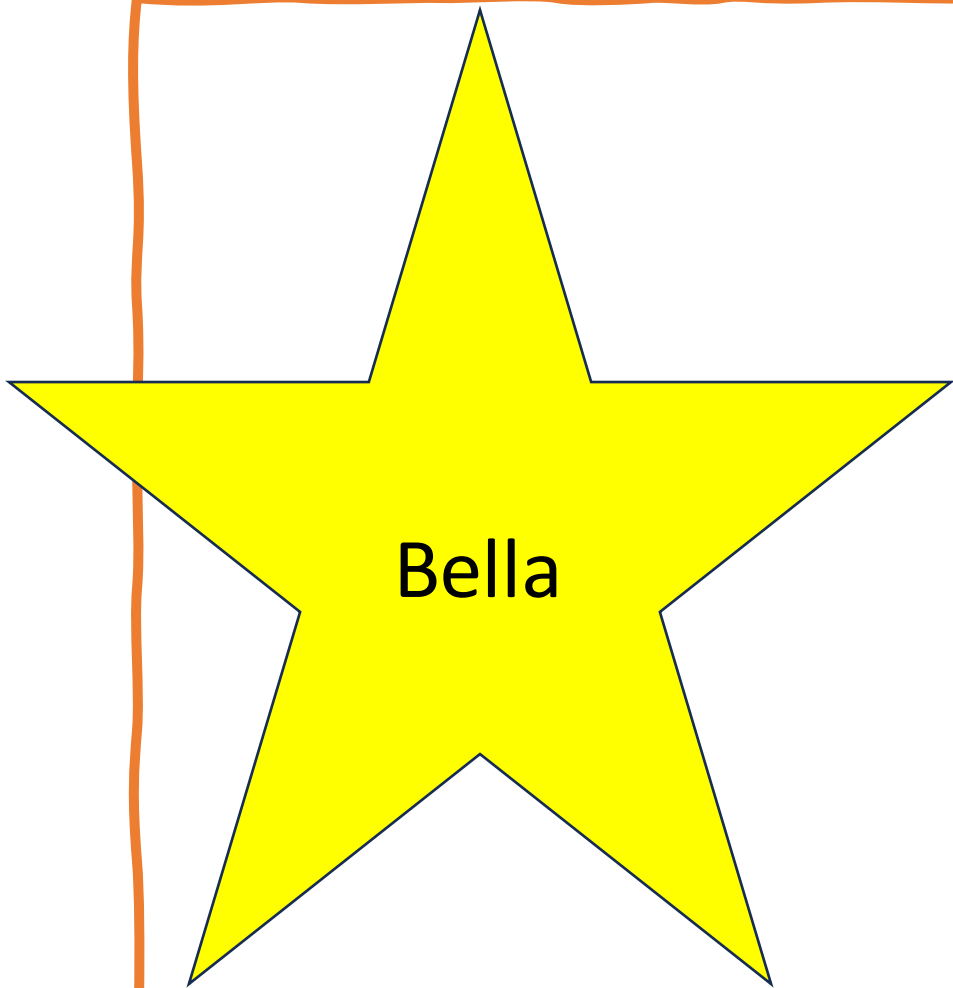
We have had someone apply for the position of breakfast club cook and she will be starting on Tuesday the 18th.

For the Fiver Challenge, we made a budget and shopping list to decide what materials we needed to buy.

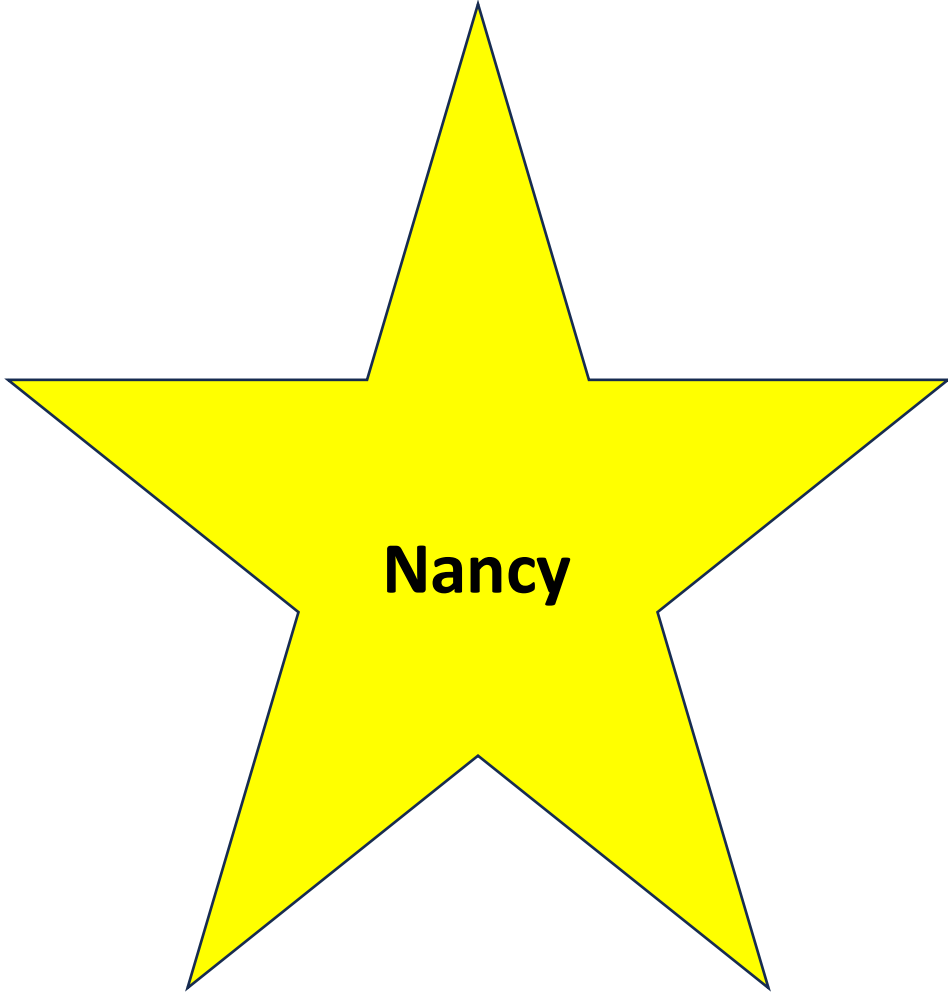


In maths we recapped 2D and 3D shapes and played What Am I? In our groups.
