The schools on-line admissions service for Secondary and Reception school places for entry in 2025 is now open.

The closing date for **Secondary applications is 4 November 2024** and the closing date for **Reception applications is 18 November 2024**.

Late applications are processed after those received on time, so it is important you submit your application by the closing date.

Parents are reminded that if their child is currently in nursery, there is no guarantee of a place in reception at that school as a separate formal application must be made.
