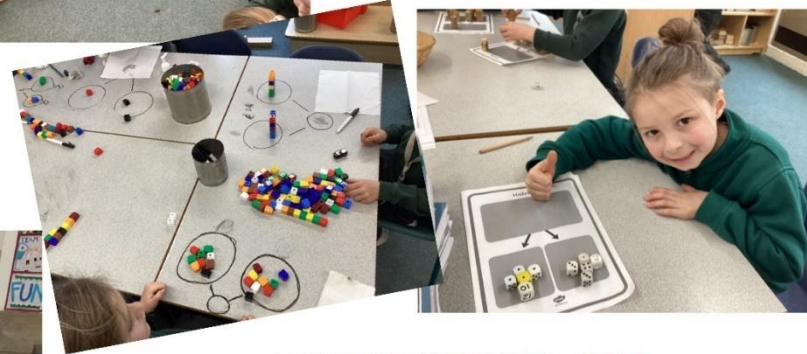

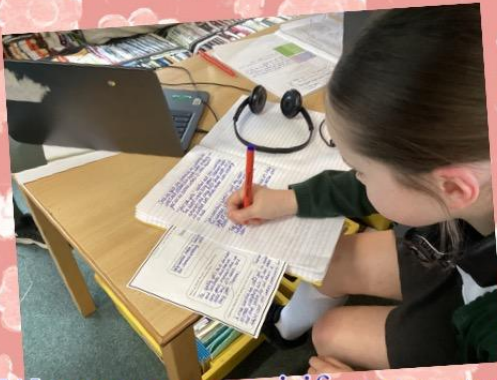

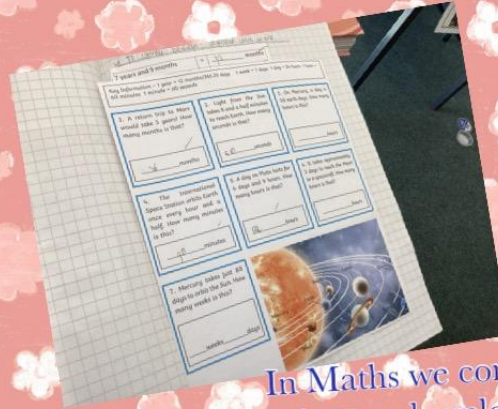
We listened to the Planets by Holst and thought about how each movement made us feel. We chose a parts to inspire the atmosphere sf our sci if stories.



We watched a bbc live lesson about space and Tim Peake was on it!

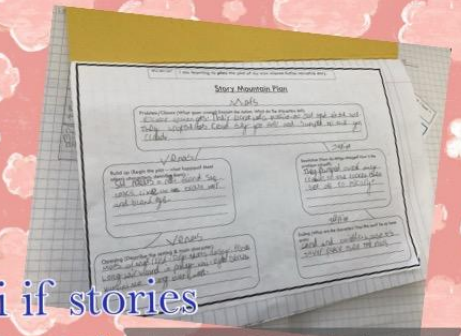


We wrote our sci-if space stories. We listened to the planet music that we chose to help inspire our writing.
