Parent Governor Vacancy

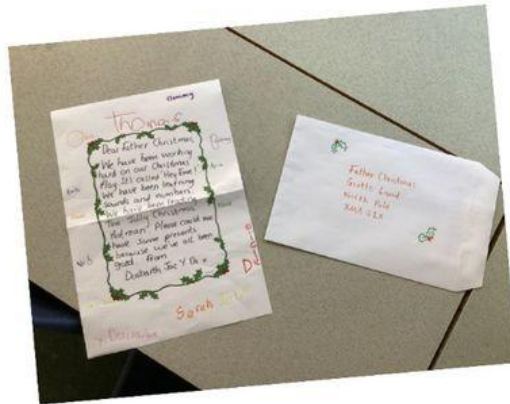

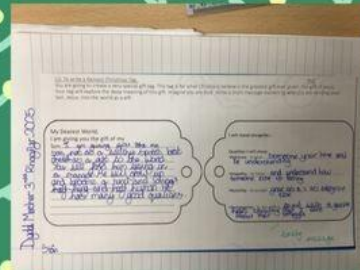

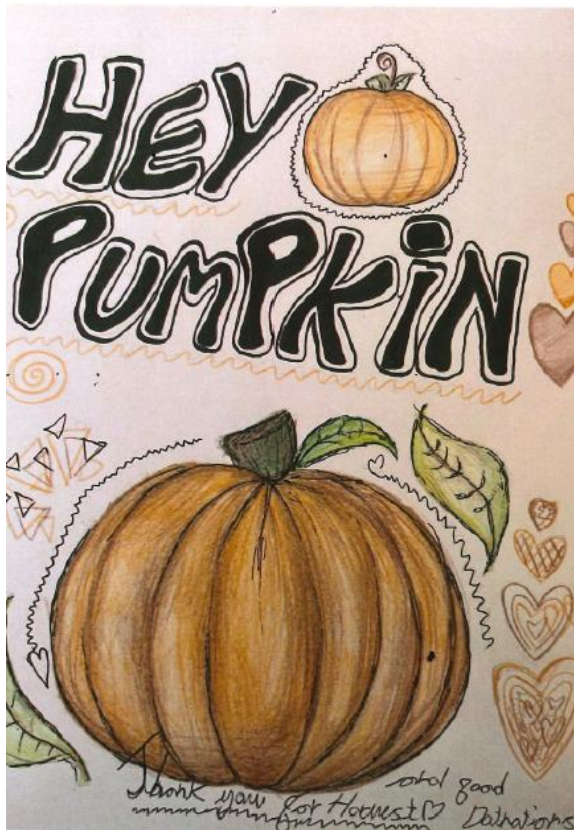
