Nominations must be received by 9.00am on Wednesday 17th December 2025. Please return all nomination forms to Miss Jones in Reception.



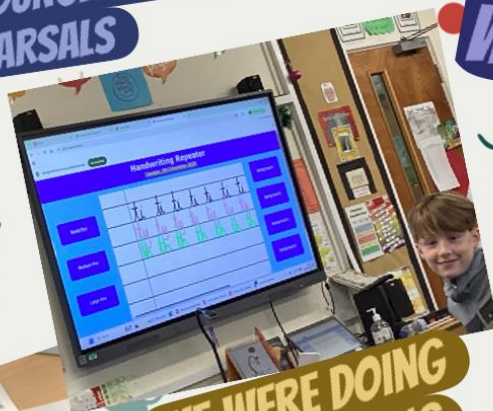
