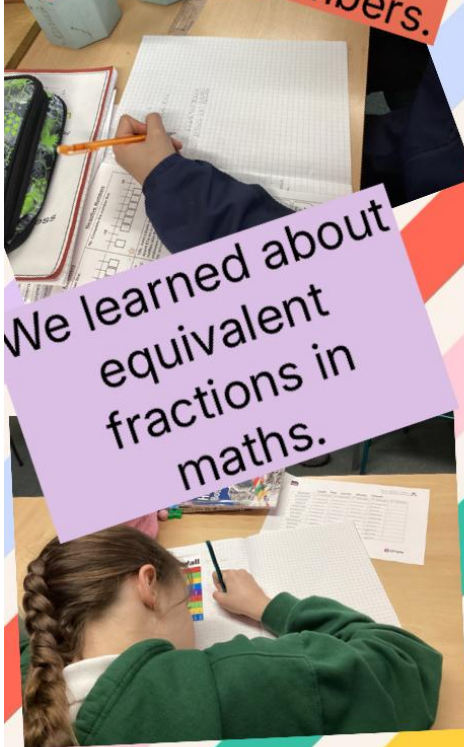

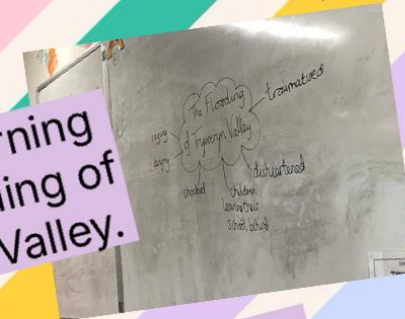

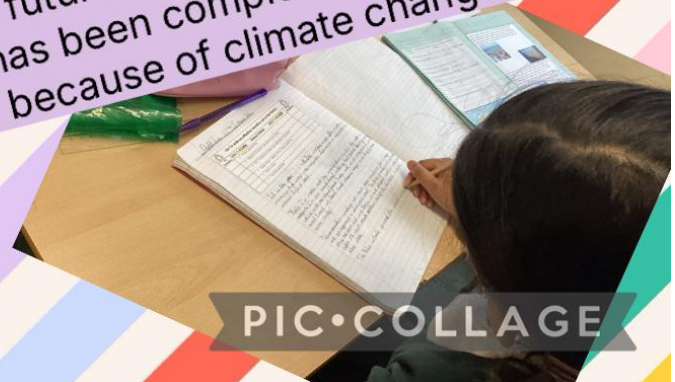

Nursery Applications

Please be advised that the applications for Nursery school places for the September 2026 intake are now open.

The closing date to apply for a Nursery school place is **Monday, 16th February 2026**. You can apply on-line at [School admissions | Wrexham County Borough Council](#).

If you have made an application for a Funded Early Education place to start in January or April 2026, it's important to note that this is **not** the same as a Nursery application. **The 10-hour funded early education place is only for the spring and/or summer term and will end in July**. Parents who applied for a January place will have already received their response letter. Parents who applied for an April place will receive their response letter on 19th February.

Securing a place in an early education setting for spring or summer term does not guarantee you a place at the same setting for the Nursery class which starts in September. You must make a separate application for the Nursery class if you have not done so already, and these applications are processed in line with our admissions policy.
