The form includes sections for you to:

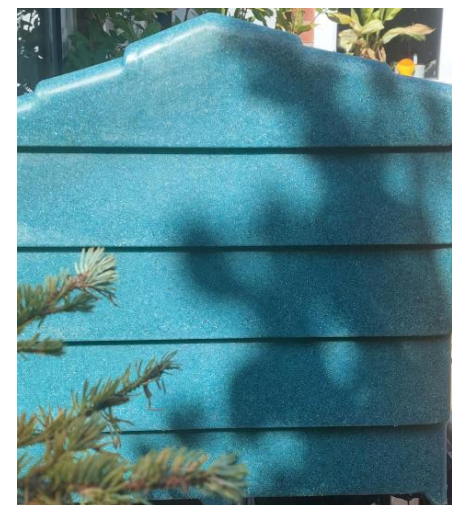
- **Indicate typical days:** State which days your child would typically require the Eyton Extras service next year to help us plan provision.
