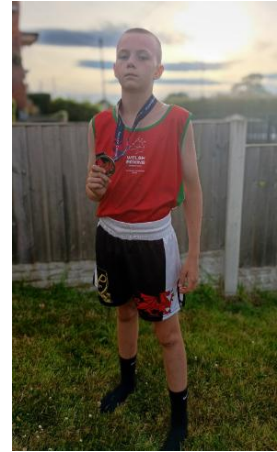
School Book Collection

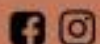
